6.2 Strategy Development and Deployment

- 6.2.1 Quality improvement strategies adopted by the institution for each of the following (within 100 words each):
 - **Curriculum Development :**

Once in 3 years the institution conducts board of studies to revise the curriculum in order to enhance and enrich the syllabi with latest developments in the subject. In addition to this academic audit is carried out to check whether the recent trends has been incorporated in the curriculum. Every semester, an academic council meeting is conducted to present the changes done in the syllabi, other activities and student progression is placed in front of the members of the academic body to get their valuable suggestions. During this academic year, workshop was organized on "New Vistas in Teaching Learning" by Mr. Mohammed Kaasim from IIT Mumbai. It was followed by another session on Curriculum Design by resource persons from various disciplines. On 2nd March 2018, Dr. Sethuraman, Gandhigram Rural University delivered a talk on Understanding the Bench Marks in Higher Education to bring in the Outcome based education and programme outcome, programme specific and course outcome.

Teaching and Learning

The institution organizes every year Faculty development programme to enhance the quality teaching. This year staff members as representatives of the each department were sent to IIT Madras for a workshop on teaching learning process to develop teaching methodology and curriculum for outcome based learning. Newly inducted staff members were guided to attend an Orientation programme for 28 days at IIT Madras. In addition to this teachers are motivated to go for refresher course, to participate in seminars, conferences and to present and publish papers.

Peer centric learning is initiated through group projects comprising of best, good and average performers.

On the job training/ Institutional training is given to the students to improve their practical and application knowledge.

***** Examination and Evaluation

To improve the overall performance of the students in the examination, continuous internal assessment, assignments, model examinations and the students' attendance are included in their internal marks. Examination Policy Making Committee is conducted every year to bring in any changes to improve the quality of examination and evaluation pattern. Single external unbiased evaluation system is followed in the institution. Instant examination is conducted for the final year UG and PG students who have only one arrear in the regular theory papers of the final semester examination. Students who have arrear in practical/projects or in any other semester are not eligible for the instant examination.

Research and Development

To inculcate research culture among staff, Management awards incentive for papers published in peer reviewed journal and provides seed money for good projects developed by faculty. To ignite the research ideas among students MRCC conducts a competition titled Idea Factory every year where the students can showcase their innovative research ideas which can be implemented. A workshop on IPR was conducted for staff members during this year.

Library, ICT and Physical Infrastructure / Instrumentation

To promote the use of library amongst the students, the best library user award is initiated.

The student representative are involved in the library activities to disseminate the services

of the library to the peers. An information service provider EBSCO is subscribed in the Institution to optimize the use of e-resources and e-research papers. The departments are provided with ICT facility to augment the technology based teaching. Quotations are taken from various companies and the one which offers the best according to our specifications is chosen.

Human Resource Management

Both teaching and non-teaching faculty are recruited after a rigorous process of screening and interview. All UGC norms are adhered to. Subject wise/ department wise panels are created for recruitment. All vacancies are filled immediately.

Industry Interaction / Collaboration

Need based collaborations are created department wise. Students undertake projects, institutional training in companies at least for one month and Hands on internships for 15 days as part of the curriculum.

Admission of Students

Manual and online applications are made available for students. The admission committee comprising of all the Heads of the department, senior faculty of the department chaired by the Principal short list the applications for each programme. Cut off is decided by the panel and admissions is given on basis of merit and first come first basis.

IMPACT

This practice has given scope for students- audience to listen to some of the values in unison. Though only few students get opportunity to say these facts, their friends help them with ideas. Thus students develop team building spirit. Students are provided with a platform to experiment and experience public speaking.

LGP- LEARNING THROUGH GROUP PROJECTS

GOAL

To develop learner centric approach among students through peer centric learning.

PRACTICE

The groups are classified in such a way that each group comprises of high to low performers, so that the high performer would complement the low performer and help improve their competency level. This will enable the group to showcase better. It is observed that the group project helps the

individual student to contribute her understanding of the knowledge as a part. This brings the awareness of the strength and weaknesses of her peer and mutually rise up to the occasion to prove that her group is the best. In this process, the students develop problem solving skills and analytical ability.

IMPACT

Peer centric learning through group projects is found to have improved participation, retention of knowledge, development of problem solving ability, analytical ability and critical thinking ability. Above all students perform best in a group as there is team work involved.
