STUDENTS FEEDBACK REPORT ON "TEACHING, LEARNING AND EVALUATION" 2020-21

The Students Satisfaction survey on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation for the academic year 2020-21 was conducted online in July 2021. 4229 students of both forenoon and afternoon sessions participated in the survey of which 90.8% were Undergraduate students and the remaining were Postgraduate students and Research Scholars. The findings of the Survey analytics are as follows:

Most of the students agreed that 87.5% of the course contents were delivered through online mode. 76.2% indicated that the LMS tools like Google Meet and Google Classroom used for online teaching were helpful in understanding the subject. About 80% of the students admitted that the course outcomes were well communicated by the course teachers regularly. 3765 students accepted that the methodology adopted by the faculty using online presentations was excellent. 74% of the students appreciated the involvement of teachers in conducting online quizzes and games which also engaged them in participative learning. Majority of the students felt that the teachers guided them to use the online tools positively and effectively in this pandemic.

81.3% of the students endorsed that the evaluation of continuous internal tests and assignments were assessed justly. 3303 students acknowledged that appropriate ICT tools were utilised by the teachers to enhance knowledge retention. Majority of the students were satisfied with the adaptability of teachers with changing trends and use of appropriate learning techniques. 77.4% of the students were content about various opportunities that are available like extracurricular activities, NPTEL Courses enrollment and placement training. The overall rating by the students on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation was found appreciable.
