2.7 STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY REPORT
FOR THE YEAR 2019-2020

The Student Satisfaction Survey for the academic year 2019-20 was conducted in September 2020. The survey was conducted online through Google forms. 4,849 students representing various departments of the institution from the forenoon and afternoon sessions participated in the survey, of which majority (93.6%) were undergraduate students and the remaining were students who are pursuing post-graduation in the College. A simple percentage analysis of the survey revealed the following results:

1. 71.5% of the students stated that the contents of the syllabi were completed by their department teachers in time.
2. 67.1% indicated that their course teachers described the learning outcomes clearly at the beginning of the sessions.
3. 73.2% specified that two-way interaction in classroom was appreciated by the teachers.
4. 69.2% quoted that concepts were clarified by the teachers through proper examples.
5. 72.6% of the students pronounced that the teachers evaluated their assignments and tests in a fair manner.
6. 64.5% of them agreed that modern technological tools were used in teaching the concepts and evaluating their assignments and test papers.
7. 63.5% of the students have been benefitted by learning soft skills, life skills and employability skills which made them employable.
8. 54.8% acknowledged that the institution arranged internship and industrial visits in their respective disciplines which enabled them expand their knowledge base.
9. 56.1% admitted that the mentors helped them to identify their strengths and overcome their weaknesses.
10. 67.1% of them recognized that their teachers encouraged them to participate in extracurricular activities.

More than two-third of the students have stated that the overall quality of the teaching-learning and evaluation in the institution was good for the academic year 2019-20. Thus, it was evident from the survey that majority of the students have been benefited from the existing teaching-learning and evaluation process adopted by the institution.
