Students Feedback Report on "Teaching, Learning and Evaluation" 2021-22

The Students Satisfaction survey on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation for the academic year 2020-21 was conducted online in April 2022. Around 3200 students of both forenoon and afternoon sessions participated in the survey of which 92.7% were Undergraduate students and the remaining were Postgraduate students. The findings of the Survey analytics are as follows:

83% of the students gave a positive response about the completion of the syllabus. Around 2300 of the students admitted that the course outcomes were well communicated by the course teachers regularly. According to the feedback received, most of the students contended that the concepts in all the papers were delivered through appropriate examples. 80% of the students agreed that the teachers gave them an opportunity to interact in the class. 75% of the students appreciated the effective teaching methodologies by adopting experiential, participative and problem solving techniques. The use of the latest ICT tools in the teaching, learning process was acknowledged by the majority of the students.

78% of the students endorsed that the evaluation of continuous internal tests and assignments were assessed justly. 2000 students gained interest and confidence from the mentoring session. 74% of the students were satisfied with the training related to soft skill, life skill and employability skills which may help them to get suitable placement. 76.6% of the students were happy about various opportunities that are available like extracurricular activities, NPTEL Courses enrollment and placement training. The overall rating by the students on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation was found appreciable.
