Students Feedback Report on “Teaching, Learning and Evaluation” 2022-23

The Students Satisfaction survey on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation for the academic year 2022-23 was conducted online on 16th April 2023. Around 4600 responses were received from both forenoon and afternoon sessions. **91.1%** were Undergraduate students and the remaining were Postgraduate students. The feedback of the Survey are as follows:

3950 of the students were content about the completion of the syllabus. Around **3095** of the students agreed that the course outcomes were well conveyed by the course teachers. **70%** of students gave positive feedback that the concepts in all the papers were explained through suitable examples. **3214** of the students appreciated that the teachers gave them a chance to interact in the class. Different Teaching methodologies adopted for effective teaching were acknowledged by most of the students. Students were happy with the modern technological tools used by the teachers in the class.

3477 of the students were satisfied with the evaluation system of Continuous Internal Assessment. **2961** students agreed that their Mentors helped them in identifying their strengths and overcoming their weaknesses. **72%** of the students were benefited with the training related to Soft skill, Life skill and Employability skills which enabled them to face Job Placement. **3352** of the students acknowledged that their teachers helped them to participate in Online Quizzes, Workshops, Seminars, Internships, Industrial Visit, NPTEL Courses and Placement training. The overall rating by the students on Teaching, Learning and Evaluation was good.
